Police Update



Advice for all:

- 1. Keep alley gates locked at all times
- 2. Remove keys from rear doors & windows
- 3. Lock cycles / motorbikes securely to walls / other solid objects
- 4. Keep sheds & outbuildings locked & bolted
- 5. Consider window alarms, house alarms & external motion sensor lights
- 6. Identify potential weak spots in your own home security





EV Charging Bays



- We have received substantial monthly use data on the residential chargers.
- This will require some analysis to fully understand and compare take up.
- Well used chargers include Portland Road, Clarendon Park Road & St Leonards Road.
- It will be useful to study kWs used, times of day, charging times and a comparison from other residential chargers to see a better picture.
- A consultant is undertaking this work for a better understanding for a forward strategy.
- We are in discussions with charging operators for more options for residential solutions to cover the considerable match funding that Government funding requires.
- We hope to be able to supply you with something more substantial to share at your next quarterly meeting.






- Objections from Sport England (location) & VPR Residents (noise)
